## **Operations Information**

Welcome to the 2025 San Diego Bayfair on Mission Bay! We're looking forward to your arrival and participating in our 61<sup>st</sup> year of Boat Racing and Family Fun Festival in San Diego. Below we've included very important information to assure everyone has an outstanding San Diego experience. Many of you have been here before and are aware of the guidelines required for us to race in the Park and we depend on you to inform others. It's a zero-tolerance environment so please help us ensure we maintain our superb working relationship with the City and Park Staff:

- --Teams must adhere to City of San Diego Police and Fire regulations. We are in a City Park and its incumbent upon each of us to be aware of their requirements and safety regulations. Common sense usually ensures a high-quality working arrangement with each agency overseeing the Park.
- --No smoking or pets are allowed anywhere in Mission Bay Park.
- --Due to Federal Clean Water requirements, we must trap and dispose of water in the Race Pits. Use of water is strictly limited to necessary operations of the teams. We have 300-gallon totes to collect the water in the pits at the designated boat wash down area, these totes are only for the use of Bayfair Staff to recover water in the pit area. They are not to be used for any other waste products. Any team violating this rule will be responsible for the cost related to the disposal of this contaminated waste.
- --Each team is responsible for controlling, containing, and removing all hazmat waste they generate. A containment device needs to be placed under your motor in the pit area, race teams are responsible for furnishing something to accomplish this requirement. Due to State and Federal Laws Bayfair is not allowed to remove any waste that is generated by a third party. Violators are subject to the laws of California and associated fines.

## Please read the following information carefully:

--All race teams are responsible for having all their credentials prior to arrival, teams will need to make arrangements to pick up your credentials in advance or off-site prior to your arrival. There will be no race team arrivals on Ski Beach (EVI) between 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM on Thurdsday September 11<sup>th</sup> to allow for our RV customers arrivals. If you do not have the proper credentials upon your arrival at the front gate you will be turned around. Race Teams will be positioned in the Area A parking lot, boats will be positioned in the Pits by Bayfair personnel. Please have your drivers ready. There is very limited space in this area and your spot will be limited to one (1) parking stall.

**--Fueling arrangements must be taken care of in advance.** Each team must pre-arrange their credit with our fuel provider, Dion & Sons. Your contact is:

Just as a reminder, you are only allowed to have one (1) re-fill in of fuel in your pit area, all remaining fuel for the event must be stored in the fuel pit as per the State Fire Marshalls mandate.

--RV spots will be available at a special racer rate as follows:

A limited amount of RV spots are available at Ski Beach ( $$500 - 1^{st}$  come  $-1^{st}$  served), Crown Point \$450.00 each and Fiesta Island @ \$300.00 each. RV spots do not include any additional event wristbands or parking passes and are only available through the Bayfair race office. Please contact the Race Office for all RV reservations (use code RPM 25), you will have to read and sign the attached RV Rules & Guidelines when submitting your RV request.

Reservations for RV spaces must be made in advance by contacting Robin at (858) 578-0884 or by e-mail at <u>bayfair@daviesec.com</u>. The deadline for reservations is Friday August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Golf carts are also available for rent; the cost for carts is \$485 for a four-seat cart and \$545 for a six-seat cart. Bayfair does not order spare carts for rental on-site, *you must reserve and pay for your golf cart in advance*. Each cart must display an official Bayfair numbered placard. Without placards operators are subject to local Police violations. Do not remove the placards or transfer them to another vehicle. Cart damage is subject to the renter's liability and reimbursement against the credit card on-file.

Reservations for RV spaces and golfcarts must be made in advance by contacting Robin at (858) 578-0884 or by e-mail at bayfair@daviesec.com. The deadline for reservations is Friday August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

--No automobiles/trucks are allowed to park on the grass anywhere in Mission Bay Park, including the RV areas. **Violators will be towed.** City Ordinance and Fire regulations do not allow Hospitality in the Pits. RV Pit parking based on space availability, first come, first served.

--Each race team receives the following credentials:

6 – Boat Team Passes: Good for admission all three days and Pit access

1 – Pit Parking Pass Boat Team for Tow Vehicle only.

1 – Crown Point 3-day parking pass

There is absolutely no auto/truck parking allowed in the Pit Area. All vehicles must have a valid parking permit for the area you are parked in. Additional admissions and parking passes can be prepurchased through the Bayfair office via your boat team RV registration paperwork.

--Boats must be removed from the Pits on Monday September 19<sup>th</sup>, no later the 7 a.m. This is a 'hard' requirement and boats still in the Pits will be towed at the team's expense. Please help us comply. We also have a block of rooms set aside at the Wyndham SeaWorld, located about 5 minutes from the race site. The rooms are between \$132.10 and \$146.78 depending on the duration of your stay, per night for a standard room, there is a discounted rate of \$10.00 per night for parking.

## **RESERVATION METHOD**

Please refer to this paragraph if each Individual Call-In is the reservation method:

Individual reservations can be made by calling 1-866-269-8927 (24 hours a day). For individuals to receive the established Group rate, they must identify themselves as members of the Group <u>San Diego Bayfair</u> initially when making the reservation. All reservations must be received by the Group's cut-off date August 11<sup>h</sup>, 2025, and guaranteed with a one night's deposit in the form of check, money order or credit card. After receipt of a guaranteed reservation, upon request the Hotel will forward guest room confirmations to each individual.

Please note: The Hotel maintains a forty-eight (48) hour cancellation policy for individual guest room reservations.
