BOAT TEAMS EVENT RULES & GUIDELINES

Last year there was some confusion over the rules and guidelines, please read the following RV guidelines carefully. These rules are necessary for your safety and the safety of others. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in ejection from the race site, forfeiture of all money paid, and cancellation of future renewals for the event.

PLEASE READ—RV CHECK-IN PROCEDURES—NO EXCEPTIONS

Subleasing. Subleasing is not allowed and the Camper's interest in a Campsite may not be re-assigned. Failure to comply will result in immediate removal from the event with no refunds.

- 1) Unless arrangements have been made at the Bayfair office prior to August 15, 2025, RV check-in gate hours for Ski Beach, Crown Point and Fiesta Island are as follows (NO EXCEPTIONS):
There will be NO race team or RV arrivals on Ski Beach (EVI) between 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM on Thursday September 11th to allow for our Non-Boat team customer arrivals. If you do not have the proper credentials upon your arrival at the front gate you will be turned around.

CROWN POINT & FIESTA ISLAND HOURS ONLY (No exceptions)

Thursday, September 11 th	12 p.m. to 9 p.m.
Friday, September 12 th	8 a.m. to 9 p.m.

RVs in all areas must vacate the event site no later than 12 p.m., Monday, September 15, 2025 or your vehicle will be impounded and towed at the owner's expense.

- 2) No selling of any kind is permitted in RV areas, parking lots, or any other areas that are under control of San Diego Bayfair. This is not only official race policy; it is also a violation of the City of San Diego ordinance.
- 3) All vehicles and RVs shall permanently affix parking stickers to the lower left corner of the windshield by removing back to access adhesive, if applicable. No taping allowed. **Stickers must be applied prior to arrival to the event site.** Failure to display proper parking credentials will result in **immediate towing** of the vehicle from the race site without notice. **Towing will be enforced this year.** Please follow the rules so everyone has a good time.
- 4) All tow vehicles must be off the grass and parked in the parking area designated on your parking pass. **All cars parked on the asphalt on EVI must have an Area B parking pass.** Tow vehicles with a WVI parking pass must park across the street (near the Paradise Point Resort) in designated West Vacation Isle parking. Any fines Bayfair receives for vehicles on the grass will be passed on to vehicle owner and payment will be required in order to return to the event. Park rangers and the SDPD will cite and tow any vehicles parked on the grass.
- 5) Every attendee of the event is required to wear an intact admission wristband, (on their wrist) at all times while on the race site. Failure to produce a wristband will result in ejection from the race site. Taped or stapled wristbands are **not allowed** and will result in removal from the race site. If you received a broken wristband in your package you must notify the race office upon receipt (prior to the start of the event), we will have a list already prepared of replacements, and these will be the only exchanges we make. You will be required to purchase a wristband if you do not have one intact or will be escorted from the event. **Wristbands must be on your wrist prior to check in. (including your guests)**
- 6) A **NOISE CURFEW** will be in effect from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. daily beginning Thursday, September 11, 2025 to Monday, September 15th, 2025. This applies to all types of noise including, but not limited to, music, parties, stereos, and generators.

- 7) Please keep all camp gear, chairs, tables, tents, equipment, etc. inside your reserved area. No canopies with top or umbrellas are allowed in the race spectator area to avoid blocking the views of others.
- 8) No scaffolding and/or lift equipment of any type are allowed at the race site. No climbing or removal of fencing shall be permitted.
- 9) Thunderboats Unlimited Inc., dba: San Diego Bayfair its directors, affiliates, partners, suppliers, and volunteers shall not be held responsible or liable for any damages, injuries, lost or stolen items at the event site. By signing this form below, you are assuming ALL RISK for attending the event.
- 10) Due to sponsorship agreements no unofficial advertising is allowed at the event site. Flags shall not be any higher than 11 feet from the ground, and are not allowed to obstruct the view of others. All other signage shall be at the discretion of race officials. No stakes are allowed to be used on the turf area anywhere in Mission Bay Park.
- 11) Campfires must be built inside approved fire rings only. Please monitor your fire and keep small enough to prevent flying embers from posing a hazard. Fires damaging any grass area will result in a charge to the space owner for repair and payment is required before future RV renewals. See www.sandiegobayfair.org for approved fire pit.
- 12) Please direct any complaints or problems to security guards at the entrance and exit gates or to a race official or the race office.
- 13) All RVs and/or vehicles must be parked within your designated area. Any vehicles blocking fire lanes or access driveways will be towed immediately without notice. There are No “U”-shaped RV compounds allowed. These rules are by order of the Fire Marshall and will be strictly enforced at all times.
- 14) There are no facilities for dumping of gray/black water at the event site. Disposal of gray/black water in the bay or surrounding areas is a felony.
- 15) There are no motorized vehicles of any type permitted to be operated within the event site. This includes: E-bikes, golf carts, off-road vehicles, motorcycles, scooters, etc., regardless if it’s licensed or not. There are no exceptions to this rule. Only official event vehicles are permitted to operate within the event site. Our security and race staff will strictly enforce this rule as will SDPD. All official vehicles must have an assigned placard.
- 16) Bicycles shall be walked inside the event site at all times. No skateboards or scooters are permitted on sidewalks and/or walkways at any time. No E-bikes are allowed inside the event grounds at any time.
- 17) NO smoking or vaping anywhere in Mission Bay Park per City Ordinance – you will be ticketed and fined.
- 18) NO dogs allowed inside the event at any time per City Ordinance – you will be ticketed and fined.
- 19) No stakes allowed in grass. We must adhere to all rules set forth in Mission Bay Park, in addition to event rules.
- 20) **You are responsible for your RV site at all times.** This includes the conduct of your family, guests, damage to the trees, bushes, plants and grass in Mission Bay Park and the cleanup of trash and debris. All trash must be disposed of in the trash and recycling containers located conveniently around the site. You will be charged any additional cost for trash/debris removal left in your space. Payment is required prior to renewal.
- 21) No drones or controlled flying or hovering devices of any kind allowed.

Remember the San Diego Bayfair is a “family festival,” please make certain that you and your guests are considerate towards your neighbors and fellow spectators at all times. No offensive signage, flags, etc. allowed. Failure to comply could result in loss of space. We need to remember to take care of Mission Bay Park and leave it in better condition than we found it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Our goal is to help make your experience at the event as smooth, safe, and enjoyable as possible. Below you'll find answers to some of the most common questions about the RV Boat Team camping process, spot requests, and event policies. We encourage you to review this information carefully before submitting your committee paperwork or contacting our team — it will help ensure your paperwork is processed efficiently.

1) What information do I need to provide?

To ensure your Boat Team RV application is processed efficiently, please provide the following information:

- Completed RV Registration forms (pages 6, 9 & 10) with a valid and legible email address and phone number.
- A **signed** copy of the Boat Team Event Rules & Guidelines (page 6)
 - License plate information (page 10) — must be submitted no later than **August 15, 2025** (If you are renting an RV, please indicate "RENTAL" in this field)

2) Can I tow a car behind my RV?

No. NO additional vehicles will be allowed through the main gates. Please unhook prior to arriving and park your vehicle in the designated parking area matching your parking pass.

- *Please note: Towing a vehicle behind an RV does not qualify as a single unit for entry purposes. Any additional vehicles must have its own EVI Area B credentials to access the event site.*

3) Can I use my RV placard for my car?

No. RV placards are designated for RVs and trailers **only** and must remain clearly displayed on your RV or trailer for the duration of the event. Cars are not permitted to use RV placards in place of a valid parking pass. Any cars inside the event grounds displaying an RV placard instead of an authorized parking pass will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense

4) Can I drive inside the event site to drop off a person or supplies if I'm not staying?

No. Vehicles without the proper EVI Area B credentials are not permitted to enter through the East Vacation Island gates at any time; this includes for loading or unloading (groceries, luggage, supplies, etc.) before, during, or after the event. Additionally, vehicles without the proper EVI Area B credentials will not be allowed to enter the event site for the purpose of dropping off attendees or campers. *(Please make appropriate arrangements in advance, as vehicles arriving without the required credentials will be turned away at the front gate)*

5) I have a tow vehicle with a WVI Sticker parking pass and a trailer with an East Vacation Isle (EVI) placard — where should I park my vehicles?

All tow vehicles with a valid West Vacation Island (WVI) Tow Vehicle Parking Pass must drop off their trailer inside the event site and then park across the street at West Vacation Isle (across from the event near Paradise Point Resort). Tow vehicles are not permitted to park on the grass or asphalt spaces inside the event grounds under any circumstances. *(Please note: The only attendee issued parking pass that permits in & out privileges AND parking on the asphalt within the EVI event site is the EVI Area B parking pass)*

6) Are dogs, e-bikes, or scooters allowed at the event?

Per City Ordinance, and for the safety and comfort of all attendees, **dogs, e-bikes, and scooters are not permitted within the event grounds at any time.** Please make alternate arrangements prior to arrival. If you have questions or need further clarification, feel free to contact the office.

7) Where do I pick up my RV credentials?

YOU DO NOT – your RV credentials/placards will be mailed to you in advance of the event at the address provided on your registration paperwork. These packets are mailed out after Labor Day Weekend.

8) What can I expect to receive in my mailed RV package?

Your RV credentials/placards and any PURCHASED event wristbands.

Please note * Your issued boat team event wristbands will be distributed off-site via your race director.

9) Can I park my boat and trailer in my RV spot?

NO. No boats and/or boat trailers are allowed on the grass in the RV area or your space.

10) May I bring my own golfcart?

NO. No personal Golf carts will be allowed on site at any venue. No exceptions. Please refer to your distributed race team welcome letter to determine if you are eligible to purchase a rental golf cart.

11) I registered and paid for the event but can no longer attend, do you offer full or partial refunds?

No. Due to the nature of the event, absolutely no refunds will be granted. By submitting your registration and payment, you acknowledge and agree to all event terms, rules, and guidelines, including the no refunds policy. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

NO PERSONAL GOLF CARTS ALLOWED – NO EXCEPTIONS

This page is due with your Boat team paperwork. License plate numbers are required. Your RV packets will be mailed to the address you provide. **NO RACE OFFICE PICK-UPS.** Must be **emailed** back within 24-48 hrs. or you will forfeit your spot
